

Preventing Retrospective Scoring Issues

When entering a patient onto a pathway, there is a **Start Date** box. This date would be when the patient has the first consultation. When entering scores retrospectively, enter a date that is before the procedure and suits the clinical situation. From this point all the **Pre-Op/ Baseline** and **Post Op** questionnaires will follow the timeline as expected.

Click the **Start Date** box to alter the pathway start date.
